






CONVENTION RULES

Department of Illinois Veterans of Foreign Wars Auxiliary of the United States Springfield, Illinois June 8 – 10, 2023

- 1. The agenda for this Convention shall be at the discretion of the Department President.
- 2. The National Bylaws of our organization shall govern this Convention. In cases not covered by the National Bylaws, Roberts Rules of Order shall be recognized as the parliamentary authority.
- 3. Delegates shall register promptly upon arrival and be seated according to Districts under their respective banners whenever space permits.
- 4. Auxiliary Presidents, Delegates and Alternates Credential Cards are not being sent out. Each President, Delegate and Alternate will register at the Registration Desk showing their current calendar dues card. The same applies to Department Officers, Department Appointed Officers, and Past Department Presidents; each Officer shall register her credentials under the title by which he/she shall cast their vote. The Registration/Credentials Desk shall verify with the Delegate/Alternate Form submitted with delegate fees. An Auxiliary President who is also an elected Delegate of her Auxiliary, and wishes to cast his/her vote in that capacity, shall register as a Delegate.
- Only duly accredited Delegates or Alternates representing Delegates and/or other members of the
 Department Convention Composition are entitled to vote, present motions, and participate in discussion or
 in voice vote on any subject that may properly come before the Convention.
- 6. No Delegate or member of the Department Convention Composition shall be entitled to the floor unless he/she rises, addresses the Presiding Officer, states their name and Auxiliary number or title, and have been recognized by the chair before proceeding.
- 7. A delegate shall be permitted to speak twice on any one subject or pending resolution. The Chairmen of the Convention Committees may speak as frequently as necessary in connection with his/her report. In the event of a controversy, the Presiding Officer shall not entertain any motion which will curtail further debate without affording the maker of the motion or a member of the group who submitted the resolution an opportunity for final rebuttal.
- 8. Debate shall be limited to three minutes for each speaker.
- 9. All resolutions offered on the floor of the Convention shall be in writing and shall automatically be referred to the Resolution Committee without debate for their consideration and report.
- 10. Department Chairmen submitting supplemental reports shall provide copies of their reports for the Department Secretary or Assistant Secretary.
- 11. Nomination of Department Officers will be at the call of the Department President on Saturday, June 10, 2023. Nominating speeches shall be limited to three (3) minutes each.
- 12. Registration will be open from 7:00 AM to 10:00 AM on Saturday, June 10, 2023. DELEGATES WILL BE UNABLE TO REGISTER AFTER THE 10:00 A.M. CLOSING. This is necessary to allow enough time to calculate the total voting strength of the delegates prior to the election.
- 13. It will be necessary for all members entering the Department Business Session on Saturday, June 10, 2023, to show their dues card for the current calendar year.
- 14. Election of Department Officers will be held on SATURDAY JUNE 10, 2023 and shall be conducted in accordance with the National Bylaws. In the event there is more than one candidate for an office, Roll Call Vote will be the method used to elect Department Officers. The Roll Call Vote shall commence with the District Presidents, who will announce the vote of the full Delegation strength of their District. The District President shall poll the Auxiliaries prior to the election for their vote to be cast. (In the event the District President is not in attendance, the Sr. Vice President will assume this duty. If the Sr. Vice President is absent, the Jr. Vice President will poll the delegation. Delegates need not be present in the Convention room during the election for their vote to be cast BUT MUST HAVE REGISTERED TO BE INCLUDED IN THE VOTE.

- 15. The District President, with at least one other District Line Officer, shall tally the votes submitted by their Auxiliaries and be ready to cast the vote on Saturday, June 10, 2023. IT IS THE DISTRICT PRESIDENT'S OBLIGATION TO CAST THE EXACT NUMBER OF VOTES AS GIVEN TO HER BY THE REGISTERED AUXILIARIES. SHE CANNOT CHANGE THEIR VOTES. AUXILIARIES SHOULD ALSO GIVE THEIR DISTRICT PRESIDENT A SECOND CHOICE IN THE EVENT THERE IS NO MAJORITY VOTE ON THE FIRST BALLOT.
- 16. All other members of the Convention Composition shall also vote by Roll Call.
- 17. Delegates may arrive at a vote in any manner acceptable to the membership, but the vote shall be given in whole numbers. Fractional votes will not be accepted.
- 18. When the report presented by the District President is not accepted by the Delegates of that District and a poll of the Delegates is demanded, the Department Credentials Chairman shall immediately poll the Auxiliaries in that District without discussion.
- 19. In balloting for Officers, a majority of all votes cast shall be necessary for choice. If there is no election on the first ballot, the member receiving the lowest number of votes shall be dropped, and so on in successive ballots until an election is made. In the event of more than one candidate seeking one office, there will be no applause after the election.
- 20. No person shall leave or enter the Convention Room during an election for a particular office, except for a valid reason, in which event he/she may not re-enter until the election for that particular office is completed. After the vote is completed and ballots are closed, a member who has not voted is not permitted to do so.
- 21. All unnecessary walking around the Convention Floor shall be avoided. Pages have been assigned for this purpose.
- 22. All movement on the floor will come to a standstill when the Flags or the Chaplain are on the floor.
- 23. At the request of the Department President, all presentations will be made at the President's station.
- 24. Members taking pictures on the Convention Floor shall not pass between the Altar and the Presiding Officer's station and are requested not to obstruct the view of the delegates/members. Members are not permitted to move about the Convention Floor to take pictures during the Memorial Service.
- 25. The use of whistles or other noisemakers causing distress to those with hearing devices are not permitted on the Convention Floor.
- 26. Please limit Cell Phone usage to emergency situations. They are to be turned off or set on vibrate during all Business Sessions, especially during the Draping of the Charter and the Memorial Service.
- 27. The Chair shall have the authority to have escorted from the Convention Room any person or persons who may create any disturbance which interferes with the orderly procedure of the Convention.
- 28. Any complaints regarding the seating or temperature of the meeting room shall be made to the Convention Chairman.
- 29. Suspension of the Rules of the Convention shall require the consent of two thirds of the voting strength of the Convention delegates present.
